In response to SNG Memorandum of Law Filed May 11, 2009

Valencia, Spain, 12 May 2009 – Société Nautique de Genève (SNG) is once again trying to avoid the Court's clear Judgment by making trumped-up allegations that have nothing to do with the matter at hand. Legal observation of competitors is common practice in the America's Cup and other major sporting events. In fact, Alinghi "spies" were photographed several times by our team near the base and on the water in both Anacortes and San Diego. Alinghi/SNG take the view that they can observe others but others can not observe them.

We believe that SNG's attempted delaying tactics will not stop the 33rd America's Cup from proceeding in February 2010 as ordered by the Court last month.
